

CAMPGROUND RULES FOR SMITH LAKE (SOUTH SITES)

04/01/18

1. The campground is open from April 15 to October 31, weather permitting.
2. Camping is allowed only in designated areas.
3. The maximum speed in the campground is 5 mph.
4. Registrations must be completed within one hour of selecting a camping site.
5. Fees are \$8.00 per night for tent camping in the designated tent camping area and \$15.00 per night for numbered sites. Campers may register for six nights and receive the 7th night free. This must be indicated at the initial registration.
6. The registration envelope stub must be placed on the numbered post next to the campsite. The registration envelope stub in the tent camping area is to be displayed on the post near the enclosed shelter.
7. One camper or trailer allowed per pad. One tent may be set up with camper or trailer at no extra charge.
8. One extra vehicle per camping pad is allowed. This is in addition to a vehicle pulling a camping trailer, or a motor home.
9. Check out time is 4:00 P.M.
10. Each numbered site is allowed the use of one 30/50 amp electrical outlet and one 110 electrical outlet. The electrical boxes are numbered to match the sites. Each numbered site is also allowed the use of one water spigot.
11. All sites are available on a first come first served basis. Sites must be paid for and occupied by a camper, erected tent, trailer or a vehicle to be considered valid.
12. Visitors shall park in parking lots and leave at 10:30 P.M.
13. Pets must be controlled and on a leash at all times.
14. Mondays and Tuesdays are designated mowing days. Campers must move all vehicles, lawn chairs, etc. onto the camping pads to allow for mowing. All sliders must also be moved in.
15. The campground shelter house may be reserved for a fee of \$40.00. The hours for the shelter use are 6:00 A.M. to 10:30 P.M. Reservation may be made at the Water's Edge Nature Center Office or by calling 515-295-2138. Reservations must be made in advance with the rental fee paid at that time. If there are no reservations, the shelter is available for free on a first come first serve basis.
16. The Kossuth County Conservation Board will not be held responsible for any injury or damages to personal property resulting from the ordinary use of the camping facilities.
